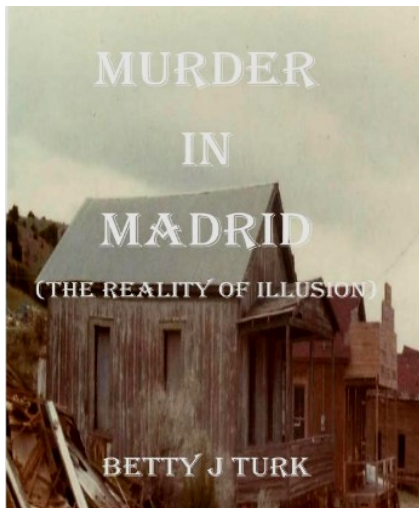

At the age of 83, Betty Turk of Rio Rancho, NM, published her first murder-mystery novel "40 years in the making", with the help of her younger brother, Jack.
